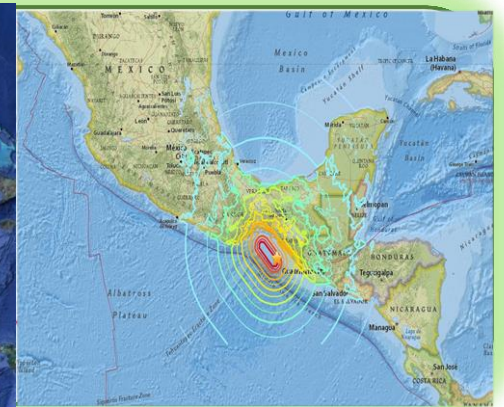

Abstract

- The coordination between federal agencies and local governments is fundamental for responding to natural disasters.

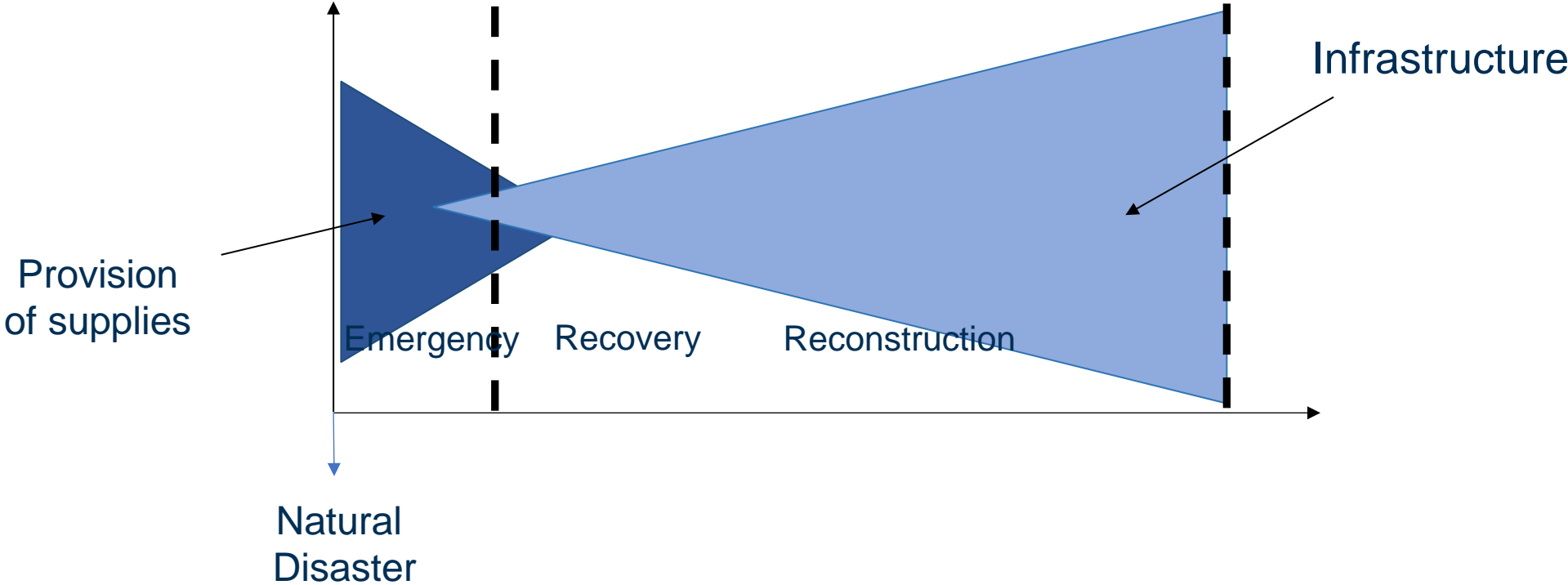

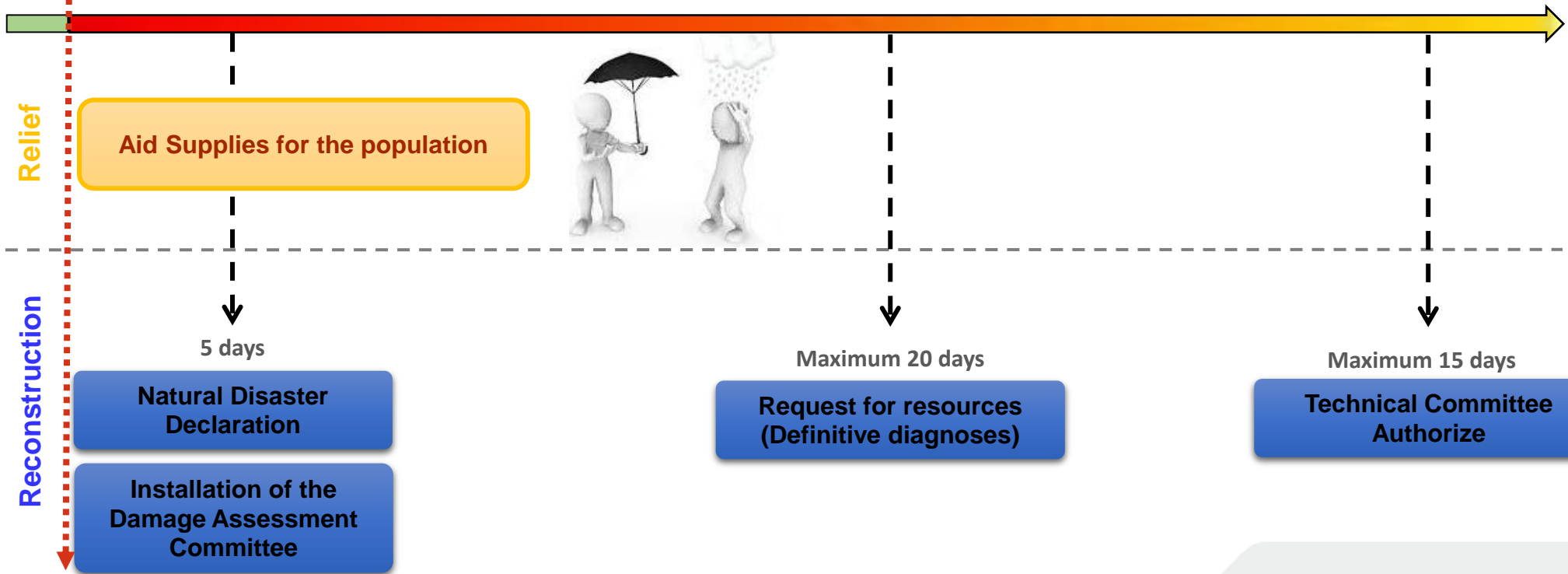

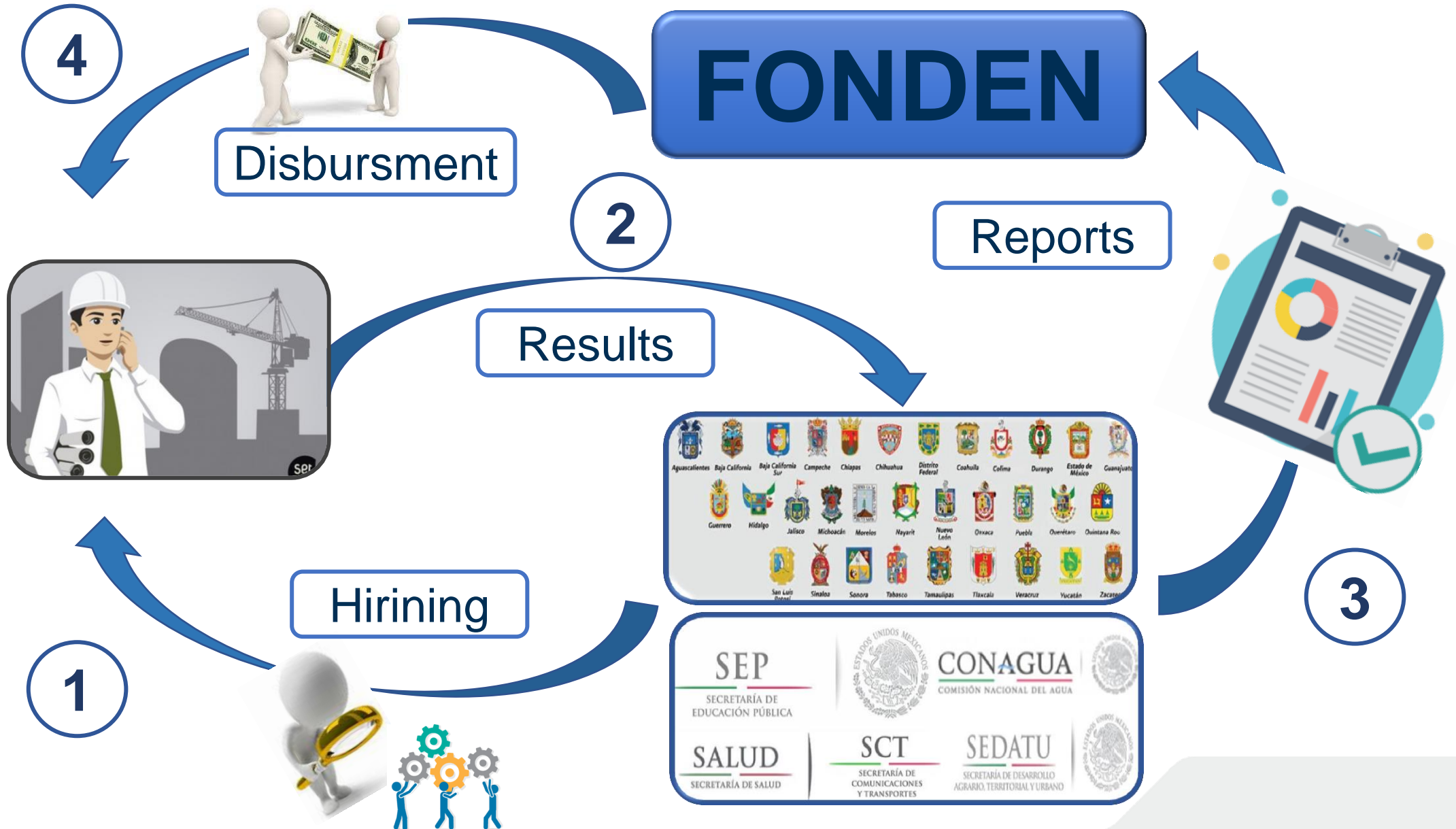


Timeline FONDEN process

Occurrence of natural disaster



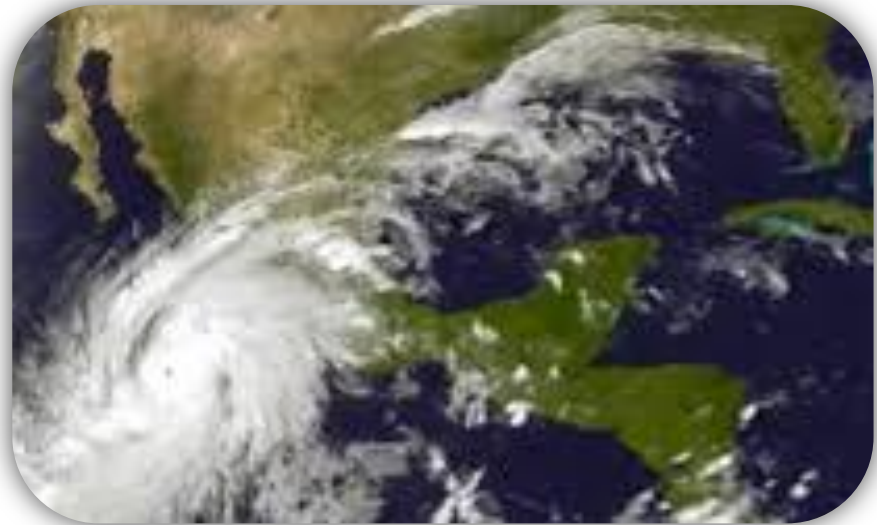
Delivery of resources
